Our Community

Our Vision is to be at the Heart of the Community's well-being. Our community is firstly Mont Albert and Surrey Hills but extends in priority through Whitehorse, Rotary District 9810, our rural partner Beaufort and South East Asia and Pacific Islands. Our Board and our club are specifically focussed in these areas but this does not preclude exceptional support for major disasters in the world. Our activities complement those made by other volunteer organisations.

Our Financial Contribution

To be at the heart of our communities we actively raise funds through key events including our own signature event. These funds are increased through District and Rotary International funding, together with local grants. We reinvest these funds in the community, focussed on three key areas through what are now well known community signature projects. In addition we support a number of smaller and lower profile projects and remain open to work with individual members to support their personal community interests. We have achieved our budgets for each of the past three years.

Our Club

Our club has maintained its non-traditional and social culture and over the past three years our membership has grown significantly and is now representative of the communities' ethnic diversity. We have attracted a broad range of member skills in the club to support our domestic and international projects and at 50 members, of whom 80% are active; we have the most active club in the District. With our growth and the communities growing awareness of our contribution we have also sponsored a new club. We are the premier service based organisation in the Mont Albert and Surrey Hills community.

This vision is the basis of our ongoing work as a club, it assists us readily to determine the areas in which we focus our attention and provide clarity in selection of projects.
